



Enrolment Process

The College enrolls students into the main intake years of:

1. Preparatory school – 4yr olds,
2. Kindergarten – 5 yr olds,
3. Year 5,
4. Year 7, and
5. Year 11

We welcome applications at any time, however we would encourage families to apply 24 months prior to start date for Years K-12 and 12 months prior to start date for Preparatory School. Click here to download the Application form: www.wcc.nsw.edu.au/enrol/.

We recommend that prospective families attend a student-led College tour and these dates are available and can be booked online at: www.wcc.nsw.edu.au/request-a-tour-date/.

We also enrol students into other Year groups when there are places available.

Once a completed Application Form has been submitted, it will be processed, and a letter will be issued acknowledging the Application. All Applications are placed on a Registered Student list.

All families who have applied are contacted and invited to an Information Evening at the College. They are asked to provide the College with information and documentation about their child. Depending on the intake year applied for, the enrolment process that follows will be different.

Please note that most applicants are interviewed, however, not all those interviewed will receive the offer of a place.

If the allocation of places for a particular year has been exhausted, applicants will be put on a waiting list for any future vacancies which may arise.

Entry into Preparatory School

Students entering our Preparatory School must have turned 4 by the end of March when they are in the Preparatory School. All relevant Applications for the coming year are considered at least 8 months prior to the start of the school year.

An Information Evening is held during the year. All families who have applied prior to this evening are invited to this event, but we also welcome other interested families to attend. We will advertise the event via our website and social media.

Interviews follow in August, the year prior to entry. These are held by the Director of Enrolments with parents, while the child attends a short play / observation time with a staff member. Offers of enrolment are made soon after interviews are completed.

Entry into Kindergarten

Students entering our Kindergarten must have turned 5 by the end of March when they are in the Kindergarten. All relevant Applications for the coming year are considered at least 12 months prior to the start of the school year.

An Information Evening is held during the year. All families who have applied prior to this evening are invited to this event, but we also welcome other interested families to attend. We will advertise the event via our website and social media.

Interviews follow in February, the year prior to entry. These are held by the Director of Enrolments with parents while the child attends a short play / observation time with a staff member. Offers of enrolment are made soon after interviews are completed.



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Entry into Year 5 and Year 7

All relevant Applications for the coming year are considered at least 18 months prior to the start of the school year.

An Information Evening is held during the year. All families who have applied prior to this evening are invited to this event, but we also welcome other interested families to attend. We will advertise the event via our website and social media.

Interviews follow from mid-May when the student is in Year 3 (for Year 5 entry) or Year 5 (for Year 7 entry). These are held by the Director of Enrolments with the student and parents. Offers of enrolment are made soon after interviews are completed.

Entry into Year 11

All relevant Applications for the coming year are considered at least 6 - 8 months prior to the start of the school year.

An Information Evening is held during the year. All families who have applied prior to this evening are invited to this event, but we also welcome other interested families to attend. We will advertise the event via our website and social media.

Interviews follow from September, the year before entry. These are held by the Director of Enrolments with the student and parents. Offers of a place are made soon after interviews are completed.
