Hours

7:00am to 5:30pm. There will be a fee for late collection of students after 5:30pm. This will operate at **\$20.00** for every 15mins or part thereof after 5:30pm each day.

Cost

Incursion day **\$85.00**, Excursion day **\$95.00** (unless otherwise stated). Fees cover full or part days. Payment Authority is required to secure your booking prior to commencement.

Cancellation Fees

Two or more days' notice will incur a 50% cancellation fee, unless places are filled. Less than a two day notice will incur a 100% cancellation fee.

Equipment

A broad-brimmed HAT, a DRINK BOTTLE, sleeves on shirt, enclosed shoes (no thongs), sunscreen and a change of clothes (in case of an emergency) will need to be supplied as well as specific items required for each day as listed in the program. Please ensure all belongings are clearly labelled with the child's name.

Food

Children will need to bring their own lunch, morning/afternoon tea and drinks, unless otherwise stated in the Program. As we are an "Allergy Aware" school, please do not send any food containing nuts.

Transport

Children will travel to & from off-site venues by bus or mini-bus fitted with seat belts.

Videos/DVDs

G or PG rated DVDs may be used to supplement Program especially on rainy days.

Electronic Devices

Electronic devices including Nintendo DS and iPads may be brought at own discretion. Use will be strictly monitored and they will be locked away when not in use. Please ensure all games are age appropriate. Devices with inappropriate apps/games will not be permitted. On a trial basis, only Year 5-6 students will be permitted to bring a device to Vacation Care.

Vacation Care Uniform

Students who participate in the Vacation Program will be required to purchase a Vacation Care polo shirt. Children MUST wear an excursion shirt on all excursions for identification and safety purposes. The polo shirt can be purchased at the College Shop. Things you need to know

I understand that:

- 1. A risk assessment has been undertaken by the College for all activities. Event locations are water-hazard free unless specified.
- 2. I need to provide morning tea, lunch & afternoon tea each day, with the exception of lunch as stated in the Program.
- 3. William Clarke College is an "Allergy Aware" school, therefore I will not send any products containing nuts.
- 4. I need to provide appropriate clothing and footwear for my child as per the daily Program.
- Enclosed shoes (no thongs), must have sleeves on shirt and a broad brimmed hat. Caps are not allowed.
- 5. Staff: child ratios will be 1:8 for every excursion and for incursions 1:10 for Preparatory children and 1:15 for K-6 students.
- 6. Staff with First Aid, asthma and anaphylaxis training will be rostered on to attend all shifts throughout the day.
- 7. Students will travel to/from excursions by bus or mini bus fitted with seat belts.
- 8. Hours are 7:00am to 5:30pm. Late fees of \$20.00 apply for every 15 minutes or part thereof for collections after 5:30pm.
- 9. Two or more days notice of booking cancellation will incur a 50% cancellation fee, unless places are filled.
- Less than two days cancellation will incur a 100% cancellation fee.
- 10. Students may view G or PG rated DVD's.
- 11. The contact number for the duration of Vacation Care will be 0409 308 835.
- 12. All belongings must be clearly labelled.
- Any electronic devices brought to Vacation Care are the responsibility of the parent.
 When not in use devices will be locked away. Only games/apps rated G or PG will be permitted.
 On a trial basis, only Year 5-6 students will be permitted to bring a device to Vacation Care.
- 14. My child may be photographed participating in Vacation Care activities.
- 15. I will provide the required excursion polo shirt for my child/ren to wear on all excursions.
- 16. I will provide a helmet for my child to wear on bike/go-kart day.
