## SELECTION CRITERIA

In selecting the Alumnus of the Year consideration is given to the Nominee's achievements and ongoing service to others. In addition, the following aspects may also be considered:

- a demonstrated passion to serve in their field or in a chosen endeavour;
- demonstrated success in identifying and responding appropriately to the needs of others in a community, either locally, nationally or globally;
- the Nominee exemplifies qualities of an extraordinary learner, by applying and building on their knowledge in new or challenging situations

The following aspects will be used in assessing and comparing nominations against the above criteria:

- the Nominee's contribution has demonstrated a passion to serve beyond the expectation of paid employment, or has been voluntary in nature

- the Nominee's contribution to the relevant community has significantly benefited others
- recognition for an accomplishment, as an individual or as a member of a group or organisation
- leadership success
- scholarly endeavour
- fundraising achievement
- community impact has been a demonstration of key College virtues
- the Nominee is supportive of the College's Christ-centred approach
- the Nominee is a role model for our current students and in the wider community

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- nominees must be graduates of William Clarke College
- awards will not be granted posthumously
- unsuccessful Nominees may be re-nominated in subsequent years
- self-nominations will be accepted

## HOW DOES THE AWARD PROCESS WORK?

- nominations are short-listed by the selection panel
- the selection panel interviews the Nominees who have been short-listed
- the Recipient is notified and invited to attend the Presentation Day ceremony held at the College on Wednesday 11 December, to be officially acknowledged as Alumnus of the Year
- unsuccessful Nominees will be contacted by phone and email as soon as possible after the decision regarding the Recipient has been finalised
