



Enrolment Criteria

In enrolling students, we seek to offer a place to those who are most likely to benefit from and contribute to the life of the College. Offers of enrolment are made on the basis of factors such as:

Kindergarten to Year 4 Inclusive

- Family links with a church
- Learning needs and aptitudes
- Brother or sister attending the College
- Parent or sibling who is an ex-student of the College
- Place of residence
- Date of application

Year 5 and above

- Family links with a church congregation and a student's willingness to explore Christ, the teachings of the Bible and possibly make a commitment to Christ
- School reports, test results, learning needs and aptitude
- Co-curricular skills and involvement
- Sporting skills and involvement
- Brother or sister attending the College
- Parent or sibling who is an ex-student of the College
- Place of residence
- Date of application

No one of the above by itself is a determining factor. As parents should be free to choose their school, so the College will select families most likely to be well served by the education it is offering. Decisions taken are the responsibility of the Director of Enrolments, the Headmaster and the College Council and no discussion of these decisions will be entered into.

The offer of a place will be accepted by the parent/s signing of the Acceptance of Offer and Conditions of Enrolment form, and the payment of the Enrolment Fee.
