Enrolment Application Fee

Paid upon submission of application (non-refundable): \$105 per student

Enrolment Acceptance Fee

Payable when accepting an offer (non-refundable):

Kindergarten to Year 12

- For students entering the College in 2017 \$915 per student
- For students entering the College in 2018 \$940 per student

Preparatory School (2-day or 3-day)

- For students entering the College in 2017 \$525 per student

Note: The Preparatory Enrolment Acceptance Fee will be credited towards the Kindergarten Enrolment Acceptance Fee if applicable.

2017 Extras Charges

Extras charges are the additional fees over and above the Tuition Fee and include a Year Levy for compulsory charges and other charges for discretionary activities. The Year Levy includes excursions, incursions, camps, elective subject fees, and Swimming and Athletics Carnivals that apply to all students in each year group. The amounts per year group are:
