It is with sadness I write to you advising that Dr Scott Marsh has tendered his resignation as Headmaster effective from 31 December 2022. Dr Marsh has accepted the position of Principal at one of Victoria's leading independent schools, Scotch College, Melbourne commencing at the beginning of 2023.
