- Family links with a church
- Willingness to be part of a Christ-centred community
- Sibling(s) at the College
- Parent/carer or sibling who is a past student of the College
- School reports, test results or aptitudes
- Co-curricular skills and involvement

No one of these things is the decisive factor. Just as families are free to choose their school, so the College also is free to select families best suited to the education we offer. Decisions are made by the Director of Enrolments, the Head of the College and the College Council. We will not hold discussions about the decisions we have taken.
